

If you're coming from places north and west, follow the directions below the line on this page. If you're coming from places north and east, follow the directions on Page 2. If you're coming from places south and east or west, follow the directions on Page 3. A list of Estimated Travel Times from various cities is contained on Page 4.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS from I-64 East at Exit 139

Traveling east on I-64, take the Sandstone/Hinton Exit 139.

At the end of the ramp, turn left onto Route 20 and drive ten miles to Hinton.

At the traffic light in town, turn right and cross a bridge. At the end of the bridge, turn left. You will still be on Route 20.

Continue on Route 20 until you pass a Dairy Queen. Shortly after you pass the DQ, turn left onto Route 3 (toward Alderson).

Cross the bridge and veer to the right.

Shortly you'll pass an Exxon station. We recommend that you fill up with gas if you have less than 1/8 of a tank.

Two blocks past the Exxon Station, turn right onto Cedar Avenue. You will also see a "Fort Culbertson" historical marker. There will be a sign on the left side of the road for Bluestone Camp & Retreat, and another on the right side for Zion Mountain Road.

Proceed on Cedar Avenue just a couple blocks and then veer left up the mountain. This is Zion Mountain Road.

Follow the signs! Veer right at every fork in the road. It's a 10 mile drive that will take you about 30 minutes.

You'll know you're close when you come to the Low Gap Methodist Church, which will be on your left at the intersection where you will turn right to come down the mountain to Bluestone.

PUT YOUR VEHICLE IN LOW GEAR AND PROCEED DOWN THE MOUNTAIN TO BLUESTONE!

DRIVING DIRECTIONS from I-64 West at Exit 161

Traveling west on I-64, take the Alta Exit 161.

Turn left off the ramp onto Route 12 and drive twelve miles to Alderson. Route 12 merges with Route 3 in Alderson.

Continue on Route 12/3. The Greenbrier River will be on your left. Pass through Pence Springs and Talcott.

Continue on Route 12/3. About 3.5 miles past Talcott, you will cross the Greenbrier River. Turn left after crossing the bridge to continue following Route 12. (Following Route 3 will take you to Hinton)

Drive seven miles to Unincorporated Forest Hill. Look for the Forest Hill Post Office on your left.

A couple hundred yards past the post office, the road will crest at the old entrance Seminole Road which is now barricaded. There will be a Bluestone Camp & Retreat sign on the right as you approach. The Forest Hill Methodist Church and Wakerobin Gallery will be on your left. PROCEED ANOTHER COUPLE HUNDRED YARDS down the road to the NEW INTERSECTION of Seminole Road at Route 12.

Turn right onto Seminole Road.

Follow the signs! It's a 7 mile drive that will take you about 20 minutes. There will be one fork in the road after about 4 miles. Veer right at the fork.

You'll know you're close when you come upon the Low Gap Methodist Church, which will be on your right at the intersection where you will turn left to come down the mountain to Bluestone.

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DRIVING DIRECTIONS from Route 460 in Virginia

Traveling West from Pearisburg, VA turn right off of Route 460 when you arrive at Rich Creek OR if traveling East from Princeton, WV turn left.

Look for signs to Route 219 North. Depending upon where you enter the town (there are only two spots), it could be a left or a right turn onto Route 219.

Follow Route 219 North for about two miles. You will cross over into West Virginia at Peterstown. Immediately begin to look for a left turn onto Route 12. There will be a Dollar General and Family Dollar Stores on the left far corner as you approach the intersection.

Follow Route 12 for about fourteen miles into Unincorporated Forest Hill. You will see brown signs that say "Bluestone" but don't turn!

Look for Seminole Road just past signage for Route 122 toward Greenville. There is no Bluestone Camp & Retreat sign at the moment because this is a newly built intersection. Look for regular green "Seminole Road" street sign on your left. If you arrive at the Wakerobin Gallery and Forest Hill Methodist Church (on your right) you've gone too far.

Turn left onto Seminole Road.

Follow the signs! It's a 7 mile drive that will take you about 20 minutes. There will be one fork in the road after about 4 miles. Veer right at the fork.

You'll know you're close when you come upon the Low Gap Methodist Church, which will be on your right at the intersection where you will turn left to come down the mountain to Bluestone.
