REGISTRATION PROCEDURES AND PAYMENT POLICIES

We accept all major credit cards, debit cards, and electronic checks.

Online Registration will require a minimum deposit that is 25% of the total fee amount(s) chosen. Otherwise, please complete the form on the reverse side and mail in with your check for the appropriate deposit amount. \$75.00 is the required minimum deposit per person for mail-in registrations.

Be sure to include your email address on the form! A confirmation will be sent to you via email with all of the necessary forms for camp included as attachments. Our forms are also available for download on our webpage. If you do not use email or the internet, please write "MAIL MY CONFIRMATION" in the email space provided on the form and we will mail you everything you need.

Please make checks payable to "Bluestone Summer Camp". Should cancellation occur, any payment is fully refundable outside of two weeks, less a \$75.00 registration deposit beginning April 1st; 50% refundable within two weeks; and non-refundable within one week of the opening date of your registration.

Bluestone has basic equipment and gear to lend out, but please bring a waterproof container for your gear and a duffel bag for your clothes.

THE BLUESTONE STAFF Bluestone's resident summer staff will take part in a 10-day training session. Counselors will study Christian leadership, camp policies, curriculum, first aid, wilderness camping skills, and safety. This important time provides a chance for counselors to build community among themselves so that they may likewise build with their campers.

THE C.I.T. PROGRAM Bluestone will hire up to eight Counselors-In-Training. The focus of the program is on servant leadership. Rising juniors and seniors in high school may apply. Check out our webpage for more employment information.

COMMON QUESTIONS ABOUT CAMP

CHECK IN AND CHECK OUT TIMES Check In is between 3 pm and 5 pm on Sundays for Discovery, Venture, and Adventure camps, and between 2 pm and 4 pm on Wednesdays for Pioneer camps. Check Out is between 10 am and 12 pm on Saturdays for all camps.

I'M NOT PRESBYTERIAN. CAN I STILL COME TO CAMP? Yes!! Everyone is welcome at Bluestone!! We are a Christ-centered community of trust, openness, and forgiveness where campers can play, worship, and grow together spiritually, physically, emotionally, and socially.

CAN YOU ACCOMMODATE SPECIAL DIETARY NEEDS? We can usually handle most common dietary restrictions. Please let us know in advance with an email or phone call!

DO YOU HAVE MEDICAL STAFF ON DUTY? We have medical staff on duty 24 hours a day, and our staff are trained in First Aid and CPR. We also maintain a variety of emergency, health, and safety standards through our accreditation by the American Camping Association.
